### **HAND-WRITERS**

Hand-writers and computer-users will be assigned to the same room for their exams. Hand-writers are encouraged to stay in the designated, proctored exam room, and may wear earplugs (earphones are not permitted). Hand-writers who are uncomfortable staying in the proctored exam room may go to the following non-proctored rooms:

- If the main room is on the first or second floors, hand-writers may use Room 1A.
- If the main room is on the sixth or eighth floors, hand-writers may use Room 6B.

All students must receive the exam questions in the proctored exam room at the beginning of the exam, and must submit the exam questions and answers in that room at or before time is called. Hand-writers who go to the non-proctored alternative room may only do so after the proctor has started the exam, must keep track of their own time, and must return to the proctored room and submit their questions and answers before the proctor calls time for the exam. No additional time will be allowed for travel.

### **FREE SLOTS & DEFERRED EXAMS**

The idea is to have everyone in the exam room start the exam at the same time. Simplified, the steps are:

1. Pick up your exam from Exam Central 20 minutes before the start of the Free Slot (e.g. 8:40 am for a 9:00 am free slot).
2. Go to the designated room.
3. Begin work **ONLY** when the proctor tells you to start.
4. Keep your own time.
5. When your time is up, time stamp and turn in your exam at Exam Central.
