

## REGISTRATION AND SCHEDULES FOR ITP AND ITAP

Only 3L Evening Division students and 2L Day Division students are eligible to register for ITAP or ITP. You cannot register for both ITAP and ITP.

### ITP (INTEGRATED TRANSACTIONAL PROGRAM) - FALL 2017 & SPRING 2018 SCHEDULE

To register for ITP, simply enter the CRN 22591. You will later be administratively registered in the Trusts and Estates course and assigned to one of the Transactional Practice sections. NOTE: If you register in ITP, do not register for either of the Trusts & Estates sections (001 or 051). Students who matriculated in or after Fall 2016 may elect to have ITP fulfill either 4 credits of Experiential coursework or the Serial Writing requirement (but not both).

### ITAP (INTEGRATED TRIAL ADVOCACY PROGRAM) – FALL 2017 & SPRING 2018 SCHEDULE

To register for ITAP, you must enter the CRN of the ITAP section you want. Consult the table below to see the meeting times of the ITAP sections and their CRNs. Registration in an ITAP section also saves a place for you in the Trial Advocacy I section and in the associated section of Evidence and in the ITAP lecture. You will later be administratively registered in the Evidence section. NOTE: If you register in ITAP, do not register for either of the Evidence sections (001, 002 & 051). In the Spring, you will be automatically registered in your section of Trial Advocacy II and in its associated section of Civil Procedure II. Students who matriculated in or after Fall 2016 may count Trial Advocacy I as 2 credits of Experiential courses and Trial Advocacy II as 3 credits of Experiential courses, for a total of 5 credits of Experiential courses.
